



MAL "Member" Scholarship Program

This scholarship program is for current MAL members *only*.

Scholarships may be applied to school tuition, workshop/seminar fees for an art class or an art-related class (such as art business). They may be for a course you have taken or will take in the current year except for the last quarter which might be for a class you would take early in the following year.

Recipients must make a presentation at a MAL meeting as soon after the class as possible, demonstrating information presented in the class. This will be done during the demo period at a MAL meeting, and must be scheduled with the demo manager. Demos should be of the standard length of time (45 to 60 minutes).

Members must apply for scholarships. One application will be randomly selected each quarter. Applications must include a copy of the course advertisement, including the cost of the course, the name of the instructor or agency providing the course, and the course content to be covered.

Scholarship amount will be for the actual cost of the tuition/registration cost of the class/workshop/seminar but not exceeding \$100.00. Scholarship may not be used to cover cost of materials, travel, meals, housing or any other related expenses.

No recipient may receive more than one scholarship per year.

Funds will be paid to recipient after the demo has been presented to MAL.

Entries will be drawn quarterly at the board meetings in March, June, September, and December. To be included in the drawing, applications must be **received by** Feb 28 for the March drawing, May 30 for June drawing, August 30 for September drawing and November 30 for December drawing.
