

## MESA EXPRESS LIBRARY VENUE INFO

Who may apply: Any member of the Mesa Art League. Please read the information below and if you are interested email me at [ljaart@gmail.com](mailto:ljaart@gmail.com) or call 480-380-0793 so I can add you to my schedule.

It is a great space, the lighting is excellent and the security is very good. It is locked up during the night and the library personnel are the only ones with keys.

The library needs a commitment that you will do a meet-and-greet sometime during your two months you will be the featured artist. It is only for a couple of hours and you can speak with Margie Trzcinski at the Mesa Express Library to set up a time. She will try to get your name and "meet and greet" date into the Mesa Library newsletter. You can do a demo or just be there to talk to library patrons about your art. Demos are preferred as they seem to draw more interest.

Because the library is not in the business of selling, we cannot list the prices on our display cards which are put next to the painting, but she will keep a copy of our regular hold-harmless sheet where you can list the price. Your contact info should be on your cards and anyone interested in a painting can contact you directly. If you don't wish to sell a painting just put NFS in the price column on the hold-harmless. I will have some cards and a hold-harmless sheet if you don't have any. (you can find the hold-harmless on the MAL web site). You will also need an 8x11 letter size copy of your bio/artist statement to hang next to your paintings. (The frames are already there).

If you are scheduled to display your art you will need to go into the library as soon as possible to get an idea of the space and to talk to Margie about setting up a time for your talk/demo. Call her first to be sure that she is there. She can get the info into the library's newsletter. Please let me know if you can fill all the space or if I need to contact another artist to share it with you.

The library is in Power Square located at the southeast corner of Baseline and Power. Go in the #5 entrance off Baseline and it is on the left-hand side inside the mall.
